Welcome to the first Burngreave Newsletter

We want to tell you a little bit about how we started...

In 2012, Burngreave Foodbank was set up by the Rock Christian Centre and opened its doors to welcome those from the community, who need help and support with food and information. All this has been done in conjunction with The Trussell Trust.

In the last five years over 5,800 food parcels have been given out.

We work with a group of volunteers who regularly give their time and energy to support the clients who use our foodbank. The foodbank relies entirely on food donations from the public to enable us to help those in need.

Looking to the future, we are excited to be planning some Eat Well Spend Less courses soon. These are a 6 week course teaching simple healthy cooking and budgeting skills.
